Introduction

Food waste management has been a topic of long debate Venue: 4/F, Conference Hall, HKPC Building, in Hong Kong. Despite the total amount of MSW disposed at landfills appears to have stabilized over the past several years, the amount of food waste disposed has increased sharply in 2011.

If managed properly, the organic-rich food waste can be turned into valuable resources. Otherwise, it can create public nuisance, burden on landfills as well as serious impact on greenhouse gas emission.


